Are you planning to spend the *Yomim Noraim* season in Vacation Village? We highly recommend it; it's a beautiful time of the year here. We need to know who will be in attendance for the proper distribution of honors on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, to arrange for enough baby sitters to keep our children safe and for the adequate preparation for the sit-down luncheon on Simchas Torah.

While there is no charge for seating on the *Yomim Noraim*, we do need to charge for the baby sitting and luncheon to defray those costs. Please see the specific charges below and make your checks payable to the Young Israel of Vacation Village. Please be sure to indicate the breakdown of you funds. At the same time if you owe any monies from pledges made during the summer, please fulfill those obligations at this time.

PLAY GROUPS AND BABYSITTING DURING THE YOMIM NORAIM

The Shul has once again arranged to have organized babysitting and play groups in the card room, from 10:00AM till the end of Musaf on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mornings. Registration with prepayment of \$15 per child for Rosh Hashanah, and \$7.50 per child for Yom Kippur MUST be made in advance. No child will be permitted without these reservations, as we must hire adequate staff to keep the children safe. Please note that the above fees are helping the Shul defray only a small portion of its overall costs for this program.

We are posting the following guidelines to avoid any misunderstandings. **No exceptions** will be made;

1. Only pre-registered children (ages 2-8) will be permitted.
2. No one – either adults or children outside the above ages – will be permitted in the card room once children are dropped off
3. Children MUST be toilet trained
4. The snacks offered are not intended to serve as a substitute for breakfast or lunch
